7A Ordinance 1070: Regarding Streets & Sidewalk Right of Way Management

The City Council has approved a small wireless aesthetics policy and a small wireless agreement Policy. Ordinance 1070 merges these two policies with the City Code concerning Right-of-Way Management.

Mayor Srp opened the Public Hearing at 7:05 p.m. No comments were received. Mayor Srp closed the Public Hearing at 7:06 p.m.

It was moved by Conrath, seconded by Tlougan, to adopt Ordinance 1070; AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASECA, MINNESOTA AMENDING CHAPTER 94 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING STREETS AND SIDEWALKS RIGHT-OF-WAY MANAGEMENT; the motion carried 6-0.

7B Resolution 19-31: City Code 131.01 – Private Docks on City Property

At the June 4, 2019 City Council meeting, Council agreed to place discussion of the City's current ordinance and policy pertaining to private docks on public property on a future work session. Since that date, several Councilmembers requested immediate action on this issue.

This issue was precipitated by the placement of a private dock on Clear Lake upon property that City Staff are fairly certain is owned by the City.

Considerable discussion was held regarding the need for proof of ownership of the property. Discussion was also held regarding the need for insurance, if the property is deemed to be owned by the City, and if the City wishes to allow renting out space for docks.

Mayor Srp read into the record an email from Erik Ordahl, Associate Attorney, Flaherty & Hood, P.A., regarding the need for proof of ownership and insurance requirements.

It was moved by Christiansen, seconded by Srp; to amend Resolution 19-31, item 2, to read as follows: A public hearing to be determined to consider a repeal and replacement of City Code Chapter 131.01; the motion carried 6-0.

It was moved by Conrath, seconded by Arndt, to require the current dock owner on the east side of Clear Lake to acquire liability insurance; the motion carried 6-0.

It was moved by Tlougan, seconded by Conrath, to direct the City Manager to work to determine proper ownership of the property; the motion carried 6-0.

Staff was directed to keep Council updated on this issue.

7C Introduce Ordinance 1072: Cable Franchise Extension & Set Public Hearing

The cable television franchise agreement with Mediacom Minnesota LLC, is set to expire on December 31, 2019. In order to extend this agreement, a public hearing is required.

It was moved by Conrath, seconded by Arndt, to approve the introduction of Ordinance No. 1072 and set the public hearing date to July 16, 2019; motion carried 6-0.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Waseca has recently received many requests for subdivision of parcels in the two-mile extra territorial boundary of the City. In 2003, the City Council extended subdivision authority into the entire two-mile extraterritorial area. This made sense, as during that time cities were experiencing rapid growth.

Processing extraterritorial subdivisions is costly and time consuming in terms of staff review. Additionally, City requirements are often more than what the County would require, resulting in additional expense to the applicant.

Today, growth has leveled off. The City does not have the same interest in exercising control of subdivisions that are occurring outside of city limits that it has in the past. Processing the extraterritorial subdivisions is costing the City money, while serving no real benefit or interest of the City.

RELEVENT CODE:

2018 MN Statutes: 462.358 OFFICIAL CONTROLS: SUBDIVISION REGULATION; DEDICATION.

Subd 1a. Authority. A municipality may by resolution extend the application of its subdivision regulations to unincorporated territory located within two miles of its limits in any direction but not in a town which has adopted subdivision regulations;

Waseca City Code Section 151.003 SCOPE.

(B) The City Council may, by resolution, cause this chapter to apply to a specified portion of the unincorporated area lying within two miles of the city borders, as provide by M.S. 462.358, as it may be amended from time to time.

BUDGET IMPACT: Cost savings to City in staff time and consulting fees.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff requests the City Council adopt Resolution 19-32, discontinuing the extension of subdivision authority into the two-mile extraterritorial area. It is also recommended that the City Council then direct the Planning Commission to look at the entire 2 mile extraterritorial area, and designate any specific parcels that the City has a valid interest in extending subdivision authority over. An additional resolution could then be passed exercising subdivision authority only over the parts of the extraterritorial area that would serve the City's interest.

RESOLUTION NO. 19-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASECA CITY COUNCIL DISCONTINUING SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS TO THE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY WITHIN TWO MILES OF THE CITY OF WASECA

WHEREAS, The City of Waseca is authorized by Minnesota Statutes 462.358, Subdivision 1a (to extend application of subdivision regulations to unincorporated territory within two miles of the city limits); and

WHEREAS, the City of Waseca has determined that due to the current development climate it is no longer beneficial to extend subdivision authority into the two mile extra territorial area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 94-110 extended its' area of control of extra territorial subdivisions to within one-half (1/2) mile of the borders of the City of Waseca; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 03-67 extended its' area of control of extra territorial subdivisions to within two miles of the borders of the City of Waseca; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 19-32 has determined that the Citys' interests are no longer served by extending extra territorial review into the two mile borders from City limits;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Waseca that Resolution Nos. 94-110 and 03-67 each be rescinded, and that the two-mile area previously subject to extra territorial subdivision control be discontinued entirely.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of Waseca County, Minnesota, and to the Township Clerks of St. Mary's Township and Woodville Township.

How does this item pertain to Vision 2030 goals?	This issue is part of a broader discussion on how to best utilize Waseca's lake assets. This impacts both developing high quality community assets and potentially economic development activities.		

BACKGROUND: At the previous Council Meeting, the City Council approved a Resolution to discontinue enforcement of the public docks ordinance that prohibited private docks within so many feet of shoreline owned by the City. The Resolution prohibited the placement of docks on a list of City properties, but that list did not include all City property that abuts Clear Lake. There is also potentially land abutting Loon Lake where docks might still be allowed under the Council's action. City Attorney Robert Scott his opined that we should have a written agreement with the owner of the dock that sits on public property at Clear Lake and is developing the agreement for presentation to the City Council on July 2. This memorandum is intended provide background to help each Council Member to consider their position on this issue prior to the Council Meeting. Both the City Attorney and City Insurance Agent agree that proof of insurance should be required as a condition of allowing the dock to remain for the rest of the summer. This agreement is not intended to extend beyond this year. It is staff's understanding that, at present, we should advise people that they should assume docks will be prohibited next year until such time as the Council takes and action setting policy for 2020.

BUDGET IMPACT: None

POLICY QUESTION: Should the City attempt to protect itself from liability stemming from allowing an illegal dock to remain in Clear Lake.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED: Do nothing.

RECOMMENDATION: Review draft agreement and, if acceptable, authorize staff to require execution of the agreement as a condition of allowing the dock to remain.

LICENSE AGREEMENT (Dock Encroachment)

This License Agreement ("License"	or "Agreement") is entered into by and between the
City of Waseca, a municipal corporation un	der the laws of the State of Minnesota ("City" or
"Licensor"), and,	, Waseca, MN, 56093
("Licensee"); (collectively the "parties").	

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Licensor is the owner of the real property located in the City of Waseca, Minnesota, which real property is legally described as follows:

[Insert legal description of ROW]

(hereinafter referred to as the "ROW Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Licensee is the owner of real property located adjacent to the ROW Property; and

WHEREAS, the Licensee has installed a private dock which encroaches on the ROW Property (the "dock encroachment"); and

WHEREAS, the Licensee desires a license from Licensor authorizing Licensee's continued and limited use of the ROW Property for the dock encroachment; and

WHEREAS, a sketch/schematic of the location of the dock encroachment describing and depicting the dimensions and location of the dock encroachment on the ROW Property is provided in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Licensed Premises"); and

WHEREAS, the Licensee has requested that the Licensor permit the dock encroachment and the Licensor is willing to permit said dock encroachment as described and depicted in Exhibit A upon those certain conditions contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. <u>Grant of License and Description of Licensed Premises</u>. In consideration of the terms, covenants, and conditions contained herein, the Licensor hereby grants to the Licensee a terminable, nonexclusive license to use the Licensed Premises for the purpose stated above herein, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Licensee shall commence no additional work authorized by this License related to construction, repair or replacement of the dock encroachment until it has obtained all required approvals and permits as required by the City. Licensee shall submit plans and specifications for Licensee's dock encroachment to the City Engineer for City's record. Licensee's dock encroachment shall comply with applicable law and City Code.
 - b. Licensee shall take all necessary precautions to protect and preserve the City's ROW Property during any activities within or use of the Licensed Premises as contemplated in this License.
 - c. Licensee shall take all necessary precautions to avoid creating unsafe or unsanitary conditions within the Licensed Premises and shall not hinder the natural free and clear passage of pedestrians or motorized or non-motorized vehicles.
 - d. Licensee shall conduct any work authorized by this License or subsequently approved by the City in a manner so as to insure the least obstruction to and interference with the City's present and continued use of the ROW Property and shall return the ROW Property, except for the dock encroachment authorized hereby, to its original condition following such authorized work at Licensee's sole cost and expense.
 - e. Licensee shall notify Gopher State One Call prior to conducting any excavation necessary to construct, maintain or repair the Improvements and comply with the requirements thereof.
 - f. Licensee shall not conduct any work within the ROW Property outside the Licensed Premises specified in Exhibit A without the express prior written approval of the City.
 - g. Licensee shall be responsible for either; 1) removing the dock encroachment and all associated costs, or 2) the cost of removal of the dock encroachment by the City, should the City or another authorized entity need to conduct work in the ROW Property and the dock encroachment interferes with such work in the judgment of the City.

Subject to the foregoing, the Licensee shall have the right and duty to operate, maintain, repair and alter said dock encroachment. Any operation, maintenance, repair or alteration to the dock encroachment shall not, except for minor changes relating to building materials, expand the encroachment. Alterations or replacement shall require City approval and shall at all times comply with City Code.

2. <u>Term.</u> This Agreement shall terminate on the earlier of (a) on September 30, 2019, (b) upon the destruction, demolition or removal of the dock encroachment to be situated on the Licensed Premises described above, or (c) upon the failure of the Licensee to comply with any material term or condition of this Agreement.

This License may also be terminated at any time by Licensee by written notice to the City. Such notice shall be given at least 30 days in advance of the effective date of such termination and shall be delivered either personally or by certified mail to the City Clerk at the City's main offices.

Before the effective date of any such termination of this License under this Section, Licensee shall remove all of Licensee's dock encroachment from the Licensed Premises, at Licensee's sole cost and expense, and shall restore the Licensed Premises to its preexisting condition or better pursuant to the standards and requirements set forth in City Code, as amended, unless otherwise directed by the City in writing. In the event that Licensee fails to remove the dock encroachment from the Licensed Premises before the effective termination date of this License, the City or its authorized agents or representatives may perform any work necessary to remove the dock encroachment from the Licensed Premises and restore the Licensed Premises to its preexisting condition, and Licensee shall reimburse City for all expenses reasonably incurred by the City in performing such work. If Licensee fails to so reimburse the City as required by this paragraph within 30 days of Licensee's receipt of a billing statement for such charges from the City, the unpaid charges shall constitute a lien against Licensee's property from and after the date they were due and unpaid. The City may take any action it is authorized under law to take to recover such unpaid charges, including certifying such unpaid charges to the county auditor for collection with taxes on Licensee's property.

- 3. <u>License Fee</u>. Licensee shall pay a license fee of \$_____ at the time of execution of this Agreement.
- 4. <u>Use of Licensed Premises</u>. Subject to the other terms and provisions contained herein, the Licensee shall be permitted to use the Licensed Premises only for the specific purpose hereinabove stated; provided, however, that during the term of this License, the Licensee shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, conditions, and covenants affecting the Licensed Premises, whether federal, state, local, or contractual in addition to any such other requirements as applicable to Licensee's dock encroachment of the ROW Property. The Licensee shall not intentionally commit or allow to be committed any waste on, destruction of, or damage to, or nuisance on the Licensed Premises or Easement Area. Should the Licensee intentionally commit or allow to be committed any waste on or destruction to the Licensed Premises or Easement Area, the Licensee shall immediately restore the Licensed Premises and Easement Area to the original condition of the Licensed Premises and Easement Area at the inception of this License Agreement or as altered in accordance with plans and specifications as submitted to, and approved by, the City Administrator of the Licensor, or his or her designated representative, or, alternatively, pay to the Licensor the cost of restoring the Licensed Premises and

Easement Area to the condition herein stated, payment to be made within 30 days from the date of written notice given by Licensor to the Licensee of the amount of such costs.

During the term of this Agreement, Licensee shall keep the Licensed Premises and the ROW Property in the immediate area of the dock encroachment in a sanitary condition, remove all trash from the Licensed Premises and keep the premises free from refuse or other debris.

- 5. Conditions of Licensed Premises "As Is" and Not Warranted. The Licensor does not warrant that the Licensed Premises is suitable for the purposes for which it is permitted to be used under this License. The Licensor shall have no responsibility with regard to any failure of or damage to Licensee's dock encroachment within the Licensed Premises. Licensee understands and acknowledges that this License grants it only a terminable license to use the Licensed Premises, and does not confer any permanent property rights with respect to the Licensed Premises upon Licensee.
- 6. <u>Licensor's Right of Entry</u>. The Licensee shall permit or allow the Licensor and the agents and employees of the Licensor to enter upon the Licensed Premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspecting them. The City may order the immediate cessation of any project or work that exceeds the scope of this License or otherwise poses a threat to the life, health, safety or welfare of the public. The City may order Licensee to correct any project or work or condition to comply with the scope of this License or other applicable standards, conditions, ordinances or laws. If the dock encroachment made by Licensee in the Licensed Premises falls into disrepair at any time during the term of this License, in the City's discretion, the City may order Licensee to conduct any repairs or perform any maintenance necessary to bring the dock encroachment into compliance. Any such an order by the City authorized by this Paragraph shall state the violation or condition, the terms of correcting the violation or condition and that failure to correct the violation or condition within the stated time limits shall be cause for immediate revocation of this License. If the violation or condition is not corrected within the stated time limits, the City may immediately revoke this License and/or pursue any and all remedies available to it as provided herein or in law or equity.
- 7. <u>Alterations to Licensed Premises</u>. The Licensee shall not be permitted to make any additional improvements or alterations to the Licensed Premises without the prior written consent of the Licensor, except, however, the Licensee shall, at Licensee's expense, make any additional improvements to the Licensed Premises that are needed to maintain the Licensed Premises in their original condition or their condition as altered pursuant to this License, or their condition if such alteration has otherwise been approved in writing by the Licensor.
- 8. <u>Covenants to Indemnify and Hold Harmless</u>. Licensee shall indemnify, protect, save, hold harmless and insure City, and its respective officers, directors, employees and members and agents, from and against any and all claims and demands for, or litigation with respect to, all damages, including expenses, reasonable attorneys' fees, and costs of alternative dispute resolution, which may arise out of or be caused by Licensee or its

agents, employees, contractors, with respect to Licensee's use of the ROW Property or Licensed Premises. Licensee shall defend City against the foregoing, or litigation in connection with the foregoing, at Licensee's expense, with counsel reasonably acceptable to City. The indemnification provision of this Paragraph shall not apply to damages or other losses proximately caused by or resulting from the negligence or willful misconduct of the City. All indemnification obligations shall survive termination, expiration or cancellation of this License.

- 9. Waiver and Assumption of Risk. The Licensee knows, understands and acknowledges the risks and hazards associated with using the Licensed Premises and ROW Property for the purposes permitted herein and the dock encroachment thereon and hereby assumes any and all risks and hazards associated therewith. Licensee understands and acknowledges that the primary purposes of the Licensed Premises and the ROW Property, notwithstanding this Agreement, are to provide the City and its residents with access to Clear Lake as well as to provide an avenue of safe transportation, and the property located therein may require regular maintenance, repairs or other work. Licensee hereby irrevocably waives any and all claims against the Licensor or any of its officials, employees or agents for any bodily injury (including death), loss or property damage incurred by the Licensee as a result of using the Licensed Premises or any of Licensee's activities or dock encroachment, and hereby irrevocably releases and discharges the Licensor and any of its officials, employees or agents from any and all such claims of liability related to the Licensed Premises or the dock encroachment therein, or the Licensor's maintenance, repair or other work conducted within the ROW Property by the Licensee or Licensor or any other third party, except those resulting from the negligence or intentional misconduct of the Licensor.
- 10. Insurance. The Licensee shall at Licensee's expense maintain in effect bodily injury liability insurance and property damage insurance with limits not less than the maximum liability limits for a municipality as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Section 466.04 or the amount stated in the Licensee's insurance certificate, whichever is greater. The City of Waseca shall be a named as an additional insured. The Licensee's insurance policy and certificate shall not be cancelled or its conditions altered in any manner without ten (10) days prior written notice to the City Clerk. Upon request, the Licensee shall deliver to the City Clerk certificates of all insurance required, signed by an authorized representative and stating that all provisions of the specified requirements are satisfied. If Licensee fails to maintain a policy of insurance as required by the City for the term of this License, the City may immediately revoke this License and require the immediate removal by the Licensee of the Licensee's dock encroachment from the Licensed Premises and ROW Property at the Licensee's sole cost and expense, and the Licensee shall restore the Licensed Premises and ROW Property to its preexisting condition or better pursuant to the standards and requirements set forth in City Code.
- 11. <u>Mechanic's Liens</u>. The Licensee hereby covenants and agrees that the Licensee will not permit or allow any mechanic's or materialman's liens to be placed on the Licensor's interest in the Licensed Premises during the term hereof for labor performed or material supplied in connection with any work or improvements performed or caused to be

performed by the Licensee. Notwithstanding the previous sentence, however, in the event any such lien shall be so placed on the Licensor's interest, the Licensee shall take all steps necessary to see that it is removed within thirty (30) days of its being filed; provided, however, that the Licensee may contest any such lien provided the Licensee first provides adequate security protecting the Licensor against such lien.

12. <u>Attorneys' Fees</u>. If any action at law or in equity shall be brought by Licensor on account of any breach of this License Agreement by Licensee or for the recovery of the possession of the Licensed Premises, Licensor shall be entitled to recover from Licensee reasonable attorney's fees, the amount of which shall be fixed by the Court and shall be made a part of any judgment or decree rendered.

13. General Terms.

- a. RECITALS. The recitals to this Agreement are made a part hereof and incorporated herein by reference.
- b. VOLUNTARY AND KNOWING ACTION. The parties, by executing this Agreement, state that they have carefully read this Agreement and understand fully the contents thereof; that in executing this Agreement they voluntarily accept all terms described in this Agreement without duress, coercion, undue influence, or otherwise, and that they intend to be legally bound thereby.
- c. AUTHORIZED SIGNATORIES. The parties each represent and warrant to the other that (1) the persons signing this Agreement are authorized signatories for the entities represented, and (2) no further approvals, actions or ratifications are needed for the full enforceability of this Agreement against it; each party indemnifies and holds the other harmless against any breach of the foregoing representation and warranty.
- d. NOTICES. All communications, demands, notices, or objections permitted or required to be given or served under this License Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given or served if delivered in person to the other party or its authorized agent or if deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, for mailing by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the other party to this License Agreement, to the address set forth in this License Agreement, or if to a party not a party to this License Agreement, to the address designated by a party to this License Agreement in the foregoing manner. Any party may change its address by giving notice in writing, stating its new address, to any other party as provided in the foregoing manner. Commencing on the 10th day after the giving of such notice, such newly designated address shall be such address for the purpose of all communications, demands, notices, or objections permitted or required to be given or served under this License Agreement.
- e. ASSIGNMENT OR TRANSFER OF LICENSE. Licensee shall have no right to assign its interest in this License Agreement without the prior written consent of

- Licensor, which consent may be granted in writing by the City Administrator upon request.
- f. MODIFICATIONS/AMENDMENT. Any alterations, variations, modifications, amendments or waivers of the provisions of this Agreement shall only be valid when they have been reduced to writing, and signed by authorized representative of the City and Licensee.
- g. NOT PARTNERSHIP, JOINT VENTURE, OR FIDUCIARY RELATIONSHIP CREATED HEREBY. Nothing contained in this License Agreement shall be interpreted as creating a partnership, joint venture, or relationship of principal and agent between the Licensor and the Licensee.
- h. CUMULATIVE RIGHTS. Except as otherwise expressly stated herein, no right or remedy herein conferred on or reserved to the Licensor or the Licensee is intended to be exclusive of any other right or remedy hereby provided by law, but each shall be cumulative in, and in addition to, every other right or remedy given herein or hereafter existing at law, in equity, or by statute.
- i. RECORDS—AVAILABILITY AND RETENTION. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 16C.05, subd. 5, Licensee agrees that the City, the State Auditor, or any of their duly authorized representatives at any time during normal business hours and as often as they may reasonably deem necessary, shall have access to and the right to examine, audit, excerpt, and transcribe any books, documents, papers, records, etc., which are pertinent to the accounting practices and procedures of Licensee and involve transactions relating to this Agreement. Licensee agrees to maintain these records for a period of six years from the date of termination of this Agreement.
- j. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. Licensee shall abide by all Federal, State and local laws, statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations now in effect or hereinafter adopted pertaining to this Agreement or to the facilities, improvements, personal property, programs and staff for which Licensee is responsible.
- k. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be deemed to have been made and accepted in Waseca County, Minnesota, and the laws of the State of Minnesota shall govern any interpretations or constructions of the Agreement without regard to its choice of law or conflict of laws principles.
- 1. DATA PRACTICES. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement is subject to the requirements of Minnesota's Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes, Section 13.01 et seq.
- m. NO WAIVER. Any party's failure in any one or more instances to insist upon strict performance of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or to exercise any right herein conferred shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of that right or of that party's right to assert or rely upon the terms and conditions of this

- Agreement. Any express waiver of a term of this Agreement shall not be binding and effective unless made in writing and properly executed by the waiving party.
- n. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. Any invalid or unenforceable provision shall be deemed severed from this Agreement to the extent of its invalidity or unenforceability, and this Agreement shall be construed and enforced as if the Agreement did not contain that particular provision to the extent of its invalidity or unenforceability.
- o. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. These terms and conditions constitute the entire agreement between the parties regarding the subject matter hereof. All discussions and negotiations are deemed merged in this Agreement.
- p. HEADINGS AND CAPTIONS. Headings and captions contained in this Agreement are for convenience only and are not intended to alter any of the provisions of this Agreement and shall not be used for the interpretation of the validity of the Agreement or any provision hereof.
- q. SURVIVABILITY. All covenants, indemnities, guarantees, releases, representations and warranties by any party or parties, and any undischarged obligations of City and Licensee arising prior to the expiration of this Agreement (whether by completion or earlier termination), shall survive such expiration.
- r. RECORDING. This License Agreement shall bind the heirs, executors, administrators, assigns and successors of the parties. This License shall be recorded by the Licensee at the expense of the Licensee as soon as practicable following execution.
