7 A. Public Hearing: Ordinance 1082 – Text Amendment to Chapter 50 of City Code

Mr. Green informed Council that conflicting language was discovered in Chapter 50 & 52 regarding required timeframe for City Services. This correction clears up the discrepancy.

B. Public Hearing: Ordinance 1078: Text Amendment to Chapter 154 of City Code

Mr. Green stated Chapter 154 has been reviewed by Staff over a four year period. In that time, Staff has identified items to be updated, as well as new code to be added. These have been brought forward to bring clarity to City Code and reduce the need for common variances.

A Public Hearing was held at 7:22 p.m. and closed at 7:23 p.m. No comments were made.

It was moved by Rose, seconded by Arndt to approve Ordinance 1078. Roll call 7-0. The motion carried.

C. Resolution 20-31: Approval of Variance for Subdivision Lot Combination

Mr. Jakes informed Council that owners Jeremy and Michele Parpart are requesting to combine three lots through a minor subdivision with variances so they can build an accessory structure for storage. A Public Hearing was held on July 14, 2020 with lengthy discussion regarding water runoff. Planning Commission voted 3-0 recommending approval to City Council.

It was moved by Rose, seconded by Arndt to approve Resolution 20-31. Roll Call 7-0, motion carried.

D. RCCA: CARES Act Funing – Grants to Business

City Manager Mattson gave information to the Council regarding the CARES Act funding. The City has received some funding from the State and would like to allocate \$300,000

worth of that funding to COVID-19 Small Business and Non-Profit Relief Grant in collaboration with the County and Chamber of Commerce.

**BACKGROUND:** The FAA requires that every 5-years we must advertise for airport engineering consultant services. Our current airport engineering agreement with TKDA expired at the end of 2019. A selection committee was formed that consisted of Tom Kellogg, Maynard Stensrud, Greg Kaelberer and Allan Rose. Advertisements for Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) ran the last week in January 2020. We received 3 SOQ's and scored them in accordance with FAA rules on February 25, 2020. The top two scoring firms were Bolton & Menk and TKDA. The scores of the two firms were close and the committee decided to conduct interviews with TKDA and Bolton & Menk. Originally these interviews were scheduled for March 16, 2020 but, because of the pandemic, the interviews were conducted on July 21, 2020. Based on the interviews, the committee selected TKDA as the new airport engineering consultant.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** This cost for this work will be on a project by project basis and will primarily be funded by state and federal grants.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the Waseca City Council adopt Resolution No. 20-33 authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with TKDA for airport engineering professional services.

Members are appointed by the City Council at a regular meeting of the Council in January of each year. Members may serve up to four (4) terms consecutively. Most groups meet on a monthly basis.

**Airport Board** – Composed of five (5) members – four (4) general public and one (1) Councilmember, who assist in an advisory capacity regarding the operation, management and improvement of the Municipal Airport. 3 year term. Meets 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of the month at 12:00 noon.

**Charter Commission** – Composed of not less than 7 nor more than 15 members. Shall be a qualified voter of the City. Appointed by the Chief Judge of the District Court. Primary function is to review and suggest amendments to the Waseca City Charter. Members may serve only two consecutive terms. The office term is determined by the Chief Judge but is *not for more than 4 years.* Meets monthly on as-needed basis.

**Community Ed Advisory Board** – A joint council of 12-18 members appointed by the School District and the City. Responsible for recommendations regarding the programming and operation of the Community Education Program. 3 *year term.* Meets 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of every other month at 7:00 p.m..

**Economic Development Authority** – Composed of seven (7) members – one (1) HRA member, one (1) Waseca Development Corporation or Chamber of Commerce member, three (3) at-large members, and two (2) Council members. The Authority will focus efforts on economic development in order to retain current businesses and help promote growth of new businesses. *6 year term.* Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of every month at 7:00 a.m.

**Heritage Preservation Commission** – Composed of five (5) members – three (3) at-large members, one (1) nominated by Waseca Co. Historical Society, and one (1) nominated by City Planning Commission. A representative of the City Council also sits on this Commission. The Commission will engage in a comprehensive program of historic preservation, promote the historical resources of the City, and designation of heritage preservation sites. *3 year term.* Meets 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of every month at 6:00 p.m.

**BACKGROUND:** The sanitary sewer collection system Schedule of Compliance that the City negotiated with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) in 2018 specifies that the City shall prepare a Facilities Plan to reduce I&I (Inflow and Infiltration). Attached Resolution 20-30, proposed to be adopted by the City Council, authorizes the City to seek funding from the State (low interest loans and grants) and formally adopts the Facilities Plan, which will be integrated with the City's Capital Improvement Plan.

The Facilities Plan provides for systematic I&I improvements within the sanitary sewer system. With the City Council authorized Schedule of Compliance as well as the City Council newly authorized Ordinance 1079, the next step in the City's current I&I reduction efforts is to construct additional improvements in the sanitary sewer collection system.

The City's wastewater consulting engineer, Ron LaFond of Stantec, will review a Facilities Plan power point presentation during the public hearing on August 5<sup>th</sup>.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** Phase 1 of the Facilities Plan calls for \$1,000,000 in improvements to be funded through the sanitary sewer fund. Revenue options include potential State funding, existing and future Capital Funding Charge revenue, debt funding, and customer charges.

**ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:** The City Council has authorized staff to establish and implement an ongoing systematic plan to reduce and mitigate releases of wastewater from the sanitary sewer collection system.

**RECOMMENDATION:** City Council conducts a public hearing on the Facilities Plan. City Council considers adoption of Resolution 20-30.

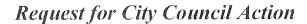

**BACKGROUND:** In March the Federal Government passed the CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act. Within the CARES Act there was money allocated to States to be distributed to government entities of populations 500,000 or less. On June 29<sup>th</sup>, the City of Waseca received its appropriation of \$680,097 in relief funds. Per the State guidelines the money must be used for expenses between March 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020.

The CARES Act has guidance of what is considered eligible expenses. We must be able to answer 3 questions:

- 1) Is it a necessary and due to COVID-19 expense?
- 2) Is it an unaccounted for expense (not budgeted or substantially different from its expected use)?
- 3) Was it incurred during the covered period (Mar. 1 Nov. 15)?

At the July 21, 2020 City Council Meeting, Council approved for \$300,000 to be allocated to the COVID-19 Small Business and Non-Profit Relief Grant Fund.

Staff is requesting Council to approve additional allocation of the CARES Act funds to the following programs/expenses:

- \$150,000 COVID-19 Utility Assistance Program
  - o Draft of application is attached
- \$ 10,000 Increase staff telework capabilities
  - o Replace obsolete laptops for staff along with purchasing new laptops for additional staff to have the ability to work remotely.
- \$111,640 Reimbursement to EDA for grant portion of the COVID-19 Revolving Loan Fund
- \$ 13,000 Reimbursement of additional expenses of supplies
  - o Examples: sanitation, Plexiglas for safe working conditions, gloves, masks, etc.

After these allocations there will be a remaining \$95,457. As the City has until November 15, 2020 to expend these funds staff recommends holding this money for any unforeseen expenses that may occur before the deadline.

**BUDGET IMPACT:** The money received may have a positive impact to be able to offset unbudgeted expenses the City had due to COVID-19. The Utility assistance program will allow the City to help residence with a financial hardship to pay their utility bill helping decrease the potential of uncollectible balances.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff requests a motion to allocate the CARES Act Funds as stated above.

Dear Community Leader:
Mediacom's contract to carry the NFL Network and NFL RedZone channels expires on July 31, 2020. At this time, we do not have permission from the NFL to carry those channels beyond that date. Unless a new agreement is reached, Mediacom will be required to remove both channels from our lineup on August 1, 2020.
Please know the decision to remove channels is never easy. However, the current renewal terms being presented by the NFL would require us to pay for and provide their channel to a significantly higher number of customers than our previous agreement. This means current NFL network customers and customers who are not currently interested in the NFL Network would be forced to pay additional money each month for this channel. We do not believe accepting the current deal terms would be in the best interests of our customers, particularly during a pandemic which is driving higher unemployment. Still, we remain open to working out a new agreement with the NFL on more acceptable terms.
If the situation should change, we will promptly update you.
