

BACKGROUND: In January of 2018, the City Council approved a new Fixed Base Operator (FBO) contract with Stensrud Aviation for operation of the Waseca Municipal Airport. The original contract had a 3-year term which expired on December 31, 2020 with an option to renew for an additional two (2) years. According to the contract, only the section regarding payments could be renegotiated at the time of renewal. On February 3rd, City staff met with Mr. Stensrud, who indicated that he would like to renew the contract for the additional two (2) years and make no changes to the existing contract payments.

BUDGET IMPACT: The 2021 budget includes service payments to Stensrud Aviation of \$2,300 per month. The Airport has a positive fund balance and receives no funding from the City's general fund.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Waseca City Council approve the renewal of the FBO contract with Stensrud Aviation for an additional 2-year term to expire December 31, 2022.

BACKGROUND: Stantec has finalized plans and specifications for two water main improvement projects to be completed in 2021: Brown Avenue & Well No. 2 and State Street South Phase 2.


The Brown Avenue & Well No. 2 Water Main Improvements Project involves upgrading existing 10" water main to 16" water main from 5th Ave SW to south of the CPRR tracks (900 feet northwest) and along Brown Ave from west of the CPRR tracks to the west edge of the ConAgra property. The total estimated construction cost for this project is \$1,000,000 with 50% to be reimbursed by a Business Development Public Infrastructure (BDPI) grant. The remaining costs will initially be funded by the City's water utility fund and then reimbursed by future ConAgra property taxes. It is anticipated that Stantec will provide inspection services for this project at an estimated cost of \$100,000, which is also eligible for 50% BDPI grant reimbursement.

The State Street South Phase 2 Water Main Improvements Project consists of water main replacement between 5th Ave and 6th Ave and between 2nd Ave and the CPRR tracks. This project is the final phase of a plan to replace failing water main along South State St from 2nd Ave to 6th Ave. The total estimated construction cost for this project is \$325,000 which will be financed by the City's water utility fund. City staff will perform the inspection on this project.

Staff intends to have both projects out for bid beginning February 25th with a bid opening date of March 25th.

BUDGET IMPACT: Total City costs of approximately \$1,000,000 (\$125K for design, \$825K for construction, and \$50K for inspection) have been budgeted in the water utility fund for these projects.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Waseca City Council direct staff to proceed with the bidding of the Brown Avenue & Well No. 2 and State Street South Phase 2 Water Main Improvement Projects.

BACKGROUND: The MnDOT State Aid for Local Transportation Office is soliciting applications for the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP). This competitive grant program provides up to \$1.25M of funding for eligible construction costs associated with local road projects.

The proposed LRIP project, 8th St SE from Elm Avenue to State Hwy 13, is included in the City's current Capital Improvement Plan and consists of reconstruction from Elm Ave to the RR tracks and rehabilitation (mill and overlay) from the RR tracks to Hwy 13. This project would take place in 2022 and the total construction cost estimate is \$1.77M, of which approximately \$1.59M would be eligible for LRIP reimbursement.

The LRIP application requires a City Council Resolution in support of the proposed project.

BUDGET IMPACT: If awarded the full LRIP amount, the City would be responsible for approximately \$445K of design and inspection services, and \$520K of construction costs. The City's construction costs consist of LRIP ineligible sanitary sewer improvements (\$160K) and street assessments (\$360K).

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Waseca City Council approve Resolution 21-07 – Approving Local Road Improvement Program Grant Submittal.

RESOLUTION NO. 21-07

RESOLUTION APPROVING LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LRIP) SUBMITTAL

WHEREAS, 8th Street SE from CSAH 14 (Old Hwy 14) to MN TH 13 has begun to deteriorate and is in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waseca intends to address these deficiencies through a planned 2022 street improvement project named the 8th Street SE Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, 8th Street SE is part of the City's municipal state aid street system, a route of regional significance, part of the 10-ton route system connecting CSAH 14 (Old Hwy 14) and MN TH 13, and serves as a congestion and capacity reliever for both CSAH 14 (Old Hwy 14) and MN TH 13; and

WHEREAS, 8th Street SE is functionally classified as a major collector with AADT of 2,350 and provides direct access to regionally significant destinations; and

WHEREAS, the Project will provide traffic calming and multimodal improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MNDOT) is soliciting applications for the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP); and


WHEREAS, \$75 million in LRIP funding is available with a cap of \$1.25 million for each project to be used on eligible roadway construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the Project has a total estimated construction cost of \$1,766,389.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Waseca, Minnesota that the City Council supports the Project and agrees to maintain the Project improvements; and that the City Manager for the City of Waseca is hereby authorized to apply for LRIP funding, execute documents required to obtain and process said funding, and authorize payments for all costs associated with the Project that are ineligible or beyond the LRIP grant award.

BACKGROUND: Rodney Born, a Woodville Township supervisor, has approached City staff asking for City support for a Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) grant application. Their application is requesting up to \$1.25M for the reconstruction and upgrade of 139th Street (14th Ave SE) and 345th Avenue, which have rapidly deteriorated due to age and higher truck traffic volumes. Because the City is already submitting an LRIP application for 8th St SE, Waseca County will be sponsoring the Township's application.

Their submittal includes approximately 1,950 feet of shared 139th Street (14th Ave SE) that runs along the Waseca city limits boundary. If awarded, the Township's half of that shared section would be eligible for LRIP funding. However, the City's half of the shared section would not be eligible and would need to be funded by the City. Therefore, an agreement between the City and the Township detailing this cost share would need to be approved prior to the start of any project. The shared City portion is estimated to cost \$200,000 and construction would likely take place in 2022.

14th Ave SE is not included in the City's current Capital Improvement Plan. However, the pavement is in very poor condition (PCI = 26 out of 100) and anticipated future development in that area will only increase the use of that roadway. Although the City would not be eligible for the LRIP funding, cost sharing for the City portion of the project would be advantageous to both the City and the Township. If the City does not wish to fund their half of the shared portion, then the Township would not include that section in their LRIP application, and it would remain unimproved.

Lastly, if LRIP funds are awarded to the Township and a project is initiated, it is also recommended that the remaining 400 feet of 14th Ave SE located completely within the City be included in that project. The estimated total cost for that remaining section is \$100,000.

BUDGET IMPACT: If Woodville Township is awarded LRIP funds, the City would be responsible for an estimated \$300K. This total includes the City's half of the shared roadway portion (\$200K) and the remaining 400-foot portion of 14th Ave SE (\$100K).

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Waseca City Council approve Resolution 21-09 – Support for the Woodville Township Local Road Improvement Program Grant Submittal for 139th St (14th Ave SE) and 345th Ave.



BACKGROUND: Work on the 2018 Street, Water, and Miscellaneous Storm Sewer Improvements Project has been completed and all work has been approved and accepted by City staff. The project is ready for final acceptance and final payment. The total project cost is \$1,248,809.18 and the original contract amount was \$1,361,268.22. Change Order No. 5 is for additional grading and dirt work ahead of the sodding that took place after electric utility lines were installed. Change Order No. 6 is for final quantity adjustments to the contract. The contractor has provided all documentation required prior to release of the final payment.

BUDGET IMPACT: The costs for this Final Pay Request have been included in the project budget. (This project was completed for \$112,459.04 less than the original contract amount.)

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Waseca City Council accept the work and approve Pay Request No. 8 – Final and Change Orders No. 5 & 6 for the 2018 Street, Water, and Miscellaneous Storm Sewer Improvements Project, City Project No. 2017-06 & 2018-01.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the City of Waseca has legal authority to apply for financial assistance, and the institutional, managerial, and financial capacity to ensure adequate construction, operation, maintenance and replacement of the proposed project for its design life.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Waseca has not violated any Federal, State, or local laws pertaining to fraud, bribery, graft, kickbacks, collusion, conflict of interest or other unlawful or corrupt practice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon approval of its application by the State, the City of Waseca may enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota, for the approved project, and that the City of Waseca certifies that it will comply with all applicable laws and regulations as stated in all contract agreements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Manager, or their successors in office, are hereby authorized to execute such agreements and amendments thereto, as are necessary to implement the project on behalf of the applicant.

Conflict of Interest Policy for State Grant-Making

Statutory References

This policy assumes adherence to the <u>Code of Ethics for Employees in the Executive Branch (Minn. Stat. 43A.38)</u>, as well as to the following statutes:

Minn. Stat. 16B.97- Grants Management

Minn. Stat. 16B.98-Grants Management Process

Policy

Minnesota Statutes 16B.97 subd. 4(a)(1) provides that the Commissioner of Administration shall "create general grants management policies and procedures that are applicable to all executive agencies."

Minnesota state agencies must work to deliberately avoid actual, potential and perceived conflicts of interest related to grant-making at both the individual and organizational levels. When a conflict of interest concerning state grant-making exists, transparency shall be the guiding principle in addressing it.

Every state employee and grant reviewer shall be responsible for identifying where an actual, potential or perceived conflict of interest exists and for informing appropriate parties. All state employees and grant reviewers involved in the review of grant applications must complete and sign a conflict of interest disclosure form for each grant review in which they participate

State agencies and employees must take affirmative actions to avoid, minimize or otherwise mitigate the impacts of actual, potential or perceived conflicts of interest.

Scope of Coverage

This policy applies to grant-making at all executive branch agencies, boards, committees, councils, authorities and task forces.

The policy applies to any state employees, appointees and grant reviewers who may be involved with any part of the grant-making process. This includes but is not limited to: developing requests for proposals, evaluating grant proposals, awarding a grant, drafting and entering into a grant agreement, evaluating grantee performance under a grant agreement, as well as authorizing payment under a grant agreement.

This policy also applies to organizations that are current state grantees or grant applicants.

Conflicts of interest may be actual, potential or perceived:

ACTUAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

An actual conflict of interest occurs when a decision or action would compromise a duty to a party without taking immediate appropriate action to eliminate the conflict.

POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

A potential conflict of interest may exist if a grant reviewer has a relationship, affiliation, or other interest that could create an inappropriate influence if the person is called on to make a decision or recommendation that would affect one or more of those relationships, affiliations, or interests.

PERCEIVED CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

A perceived conflict of interest is any situation in which a reasonable third party would conclude that conflicting duties or loyalties exist.

This policy supersedes other state agency policies that concern conflicts of interest relating to outgoing grants except when the existing state agency policy is stricter.

Grant programs that seek an exception to this policy must complete a Grants Policy Exception Request and submit it to the Office of Grants Management for the approval of the Commissioner of Administration.

Definitions

Grant:

A grant is the transfer of cash or something of value to a recipient to support a public purpose authorized by law.

Conflict of Interest:

A conflict of interest, actual, potential, or perceived, occurs when a person has actual or apparent duty or loyalty to more than one organization and the competing duties or loyalties may result in actions which are adverse to one or both parties. A conflict of interest exists even if no unethical, improper or illegal act results from it.

Individual Conflict of Interest:

A conflict of interest that may benefit an individual employee or grant reviewer is any situation in which a state employee or grant reviewer's judgment, actions or non-action could be interpreted to be influenced by something that would benefit them directly or through indirect gain to a friend, relative, acquaintance or business or organization with which they are involved.

An individual conflict of interest occurs when any of the following conditions is present: (a) A state employee or a grant reviewer uses his/her status or position to obtain special advantage, benefit, or access to the grantee or grant applicant's time, services, facilities, equipment, supplies, badge, uniform, prestige, or influence.

(b) A state employee or a grant reviewer receives or accepts money or anything else of value from a state grantee or grant applicant or has equity or a financial interest in or partial or whole ownership of an applicant organization.

(c) A state employee or a grant reviewer is an employee or board member of a grant applicant or grantee or is an immediate family member of an owner, employee or board member of the grantee or grant applicant.

Instances in which the state employee or grant reviewer works in a volunteer capacity for a grant applicant or grantee organization should be evaluated on a case by case basis. Volunteer status has the potential to but does not necessarily create a conflict of interest, depending on the nature of the relationship between the two parties.

Procedures to Avoid Individual Conflicts of Interest:

- 1. All state employees and grant reviewers involved in the review of grant applications must complete and sign a conflict of interest disclosure form for each grant review in which they participate. On the conflict of interest disclosure form, each reviewer <u>must</u> identify any grant applicant with which they have an actual, potential or perceived conflict of interest, although they do not need to provide the reason for the conflict on the disclosure form.
- 2. State agency personnel or grant reviewers must act immediately upon any suggestion, inquiry, or intimation that a conflict of interest exists at any point in the grants process. Upon identification, such matters are referred to appropriate agency or grant program personnel (the employee's immediate supervisor, RFP contact person, or grant program manager) for additional discussion to identify and mitigate any potential conflicts. If the conflict involves the employee's immediate supervisor, grant program manager, or RFP contact person, the employee or grant reviewer should instead contact the agency's ethics officer or a manager, director, assistant commissioner or agency head.
- 3. If it is determined that an actual, potential or perceived conflict of interest exists, as defined by this policy or other relevant law, it is important that appropriate steps must be taken to avoid the conflict. These steps may include:
 - reassigning the duties associated with that particular applicant, grant or grantee to another employee or grant reviewer
 - requiring the state employee or grant reviewer to remove themselves from the discussion or decision about a particular applicant(s) that is affected by the conflict and avoid discussing the applicant and/or applications from organizations with which the reviewer has disclosed a conflict of interest with other reviewers

At a minimum, all internal parties who are involved in the grant review or grant management process must be made aware that an actual, potential or perceived conflict has been disclosed and evaluated, even if it is not serious enough to remove or reassign the employee or grant reviewer.

4. Any disclosed conflicts and their resolution should be noted in meeting minutes, documents or records that the state agency keeps as a regular part of its grants process.

Organizational Conflict of Interest:

A conflict of interest can also occur with an organization that is a grant applicant or grantee of a state agency.

Organizational conflicts of interest occur when:

- a grantee is unable or potentially unable to render impartial assistance or advice to the State due to competing duties or loyalties
- a grantee's objectivity in carrying out the grant is or might be otherwise impaired due to competing duties or loyalties
- a grantee or potential grantee has an unfair competitive advantage through being furnished unauthorized proprietary information or source selection information that is not available to all competitors.

Particular attention should be paid to any proposed grant agreement requirements that provide for the rendering of planning, consultation, evaluation, or similar activities that may inform decisions on future grant awards.

Procedures to Avoid Organizational Conflicts of Interest:

- 1. Conflicts of interest should be prevented as early in the grants process as possible. This includes writing requests for proposals in a manner that avoids conflicts and creates a level playing field for all grant applicants. Agencies may also consider including questions as part of the Request for Proposals (RFP) process to identify how potential grant applicants manage conflicts of interest, which may include information such as the applicant's conflict of interest policies or procedures.
- 2. If an organizational conflict of interest is suspected, disclosed or discovered agency staff must immediately notify the agency's ethics officer or a supervisor, manager, director, assistant commissioner or commissioner.
- 3. In cases where an organizational conflict of interest is suspected, disclosed or discovered, the grantee or grant applicant organization should be notified by the state agency regarding the actual or potential conflict and allowed a reasonable opportunity to respond. Based on a review of the response and other relevant facts, one of the following actions may be pursued:
- The potential grantee is disqualified from eligibility for the grant award
- A current grantee's grant agreement is terminated
- The grantee is disqualified from subsequent state grant awards if it is determined that it improperly failed to disclose a known organizational conflict of interest or misrepresented information regarding such a conflict
- The responsibility for the grant or grant program is reassigned to a different state employee
- Actions should be taken to mitigate or neutralize perceived or actual organizational conflicts of interest. This may include: revising the grantee's duties so that the conflict is mitigated; allowing the grantee to propose the exclusion of task areas that create a conflict, if appropriate; asking the grantee to submit an organizational conflict of interest avoidance or mitigation plan; or making all information available to all grantees and/or potential grantees in order to eliminate favoritism toward any one grantee.

Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form

This form gives grantees an opportunity to disclose any actual, potential or perceived conflicts of interest that may exist when receiving a grant. It is the grantee's obligation to be familiar with the Office of Grants Management (OGM) Policy 08-01, Conflict of Interest Policy for State Grant-Making, specifically the section related to organizational conflict of interest.
