

Who would qualify?

- New business customers with a load of 250 kW or greater**
- Existing customers adding new incremental connected load of 250 kW or greater**
- Existing customers in distress that have legitimate opportunities to move operations outside of Waseca's Utilities Service Area
- \circ **or exceeds the demand of our 10^{th} largest current retail customer which would be about 110~kW

What are the incentives?

- SMMPA will calculate an economic development credit to be paid to
 Waseca Utilities based on the energy usage of the qualifying business
- For incremental load, the credit only applies to the additional energy associated with the business expansion

New Business and/or business expansion

- Strategic load growth can be beneficial for all Waseca Utilities electric utility customers.
- To the extent that is does not require investment in major new infrastructure, the ability to spread the fixed costs over more units of energy puts downward pressure on retail rates.
- SMMPA uses economic development incentives at the wholesale level to help promote strategic load growth at the retail level

Business Retention

- Business Customers facing economic distress must have received no less than \$25,000 in local, county, state of Minnesota and/or federal financial assistance for economic development or economic stimulus
- The business must meet all conditions set forth by the member city for local economic development
- Businesses cannot be transferring load from a different SMMPA member
- Business must review the energy efficiency program opportunities available from Waseca Utilities

Who makes the decision?

- When it comes to new or expanding businesses, application is made to Waseca Utilities, who have the final decision
- When it comes to retention of a business, application is made to SMMPA Board of Directors, who have the final decision

2. A moment of silence was observed. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited.

5. Motion made by Schroeder to ask the Economic Development Authority (EDA) to make an in-kind donation of \$1,500 (or 50% of total cost) for a review of sales tax in Waseca to provide a basis for any future conversations on the Local Optional Sales Tax (LOST). No matter the decision from the EDA the motion is to approve the \$3,000 spending from the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) on a Sales Tax review, seconded by Mansfield. Motion carried 6-1. (Nay, Conrath)

REPORTS

8.

A. City Manager's Report:

- i. There were no proposals received from the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Gaiter Lake Property.
 - a. Will be discussed at a later work session with staff providing some options and council providing some options
- ii. "No Mow May" is not an event in the City of Waseca, and City Code will still be enforced. Any questions contact City Hall.
- iii. There have been 3 events of vandalism already in the City Parks Restrooms, Clear Lake Park Beach House, Trowbridge Park, and Northeast Park. Staff has some suggestions on how to help deter vandals.
 - a. Clear Lake Park Pavilion will be getting cameras per the approved plan for renovations.
 - b. Cameras are budgeted in the Capital Improvement Plans for 2024, 2025 and 2026 to install exterior cameras at the parks. This could be moved to an earlier date using funds that have been saved from estimates vs. actual costs on other projects in the city. Cameras would be provided by local company Streamline, and install would be completed by city staff.
 - c. If exterior cameras are not approved, it would be suggested that all bathrooms be closed, and the city rents portable toilets at each park.
 - d. An update to the trespassing guidelines is being completed and will be posted at parks. This will help hold the vandals accountable.
- iv. May 16th work session will be about the City Parks and the Waterpark.
- v. There was only one power outage last month and that was a private residence, the city electrical team assisted them in restoring their electricity.
- vi. Waseca Area Foundation awarded three grants to the city. \$2,351 for hanging flower baskets, \$2,000 for picnic tables at the waterpark and \$1,000 for special events at the waterpark.
- vii. Lakefest received \$25,000 annually from the City of Waseca for their event.
- **Commission Reports**
 - i. Airport Board: Councilmember Schroeder reported that Blue Earth Aviation is looking to set up crop dusting. Repairs continue to be made at the airport as they are discovered. Proof of insurance was obtained for the privately owned hangar. There is a dip in the runway that is being looked at. Also looking at how to handle rental contracts and the new hangar space.
 - ii. Fire Relief Board: Councilmember Conrath reported that they spent their meeting discussing the fish fry and he was happy to announce that they have ordered more fish than they did in the past.
 - iii. Heritage Preservation Commission: Councilmember Ebertowski reported that the HPC was awarded a Waseca Area Foundation to work on the project with the school

- district that will promote the Downtown Historic District and other areas in the City. Also working on updating the process for Historical District permits.
- iv. Park Board: Councilmembers Christiansen reported that they discussed the 2023 large park projects, Tink Larson Field fence project is completed, Clear Lake Park frontage road mill and overlay, completion and reconstruct of Doodlebug Trail; still need to complete from 11th to the Jr. high, Southview Park basketball court and park trail resurfacing, tennis and basketball courts at Clear Lake Park, and dog park dirt and landscaping. Lakefest is being organized this year by Tom Sexton, for the Lakes Association. At Clear Lake playground there have been bikes and scooters etc. on the sidewalks, please be respectful of the parks and equipment. Bathrooms are opening and Tink Larson field has started games. The park clean-up had about 45 people. There was a clean-up of the dog park, please remember to pick-up after your dogs. Reminder, May 16th the work session will be with the City Parks Director.

BACKGROUND: Council has had preliminary conversations about a LOST initiative during 2023 for possible presentation to the State legislature in 2024 with ultimate presentation to the voters on the 2024 ballot.

Council is being asked to determine the appropriateness of asking the University of Minnesota Extension Office of Regional Community Economics to prepare a sales tax revenue data report for projected revenue in support of a possible bond to construct community amenities in the coming years. A bond would be paid for with sales tax revenue.

The report preparation takes six to eight weeks to process and analyze the data. The report will include expected tax revenue, on-line revenue considerations, and will provide current sales tax data. Also, some perspective will be provided whether sales tax is being paid by a city resident or visitor.

BUDGET IMPACT: The cost of research to produce projected sales tax revenue is \$3,000.00. There may be an added fee for a presentation to the Council.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED: The University Extension Office has been widely relied upon to produce sales tax data since 2015.

RECOMMENDATION: City Council action to authorize the Mayor and City Manager to execute required sales tax revenue projection documents with the University Extension Office of Regional Community Economics.

BACKGROUND: Dean Morgan, on behalf of SIG Properties LLC, dba Morgan's Meat Market, owner of the property. Dean Morgan is requesting a Conditional Use Permit and a Variance from the City of Waseca Code of Ordinances.

The Conditional Use Permit is from Section 154.022, Table 5-1. Custom Meat Processing in the B-3 District is allowed through a Conditional Use Permit.

The Variance is from Section 154.025, Table 5-7: Required Setbacks, B-3 District. The required minimum setback from the property line is 15 feet for the rear of a principal building. The proposed addition will encroach five (5) feet into the setback, leaving a distance of ten (10) feet.

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on the Conditional Use Permit and Variance request on May 9, 2023. The Planning Commission voted to recommend approval by a vote of 5-0.

APPLICANT

The applicant is Dean Morgan, on behalf of SIG Properties LLC, dba Morgan's Meat Market, owner of the property. A complete application was received on April 21, 2023. Final action, which is required within 60 days of the complete application date, must be taken by June 20, 2023.

REQUEST

The applicant is requesting a conditional use permit and variance to expand the meat processing business by adding an approximate 2,180 square foot addition to add operation and storage capacity at the location.

LOCATION

The property is located at 1100 2nd St NW and is described as:

LAND USE

The parcel is 1.13 acres in size and is currently occupied by one building currently used for processing and retail space, and a detached garage structure. The Land Use Plan designates this property as Commercial.

ZONING

The property is zoned B-3, Neighborhood Transition Business District. Adjacent zoning to the north, east, and south is B-3. Across 2^{nd} St NW to the west is R-1, Suburban Residential District.

ENVIRONMENTAL

There are no known environmental issues related to the project. All uses shall comply with the standards as regulated by the USDA.

PUBLIC UTILITIES

The property is fully served with municipal utilities. No new public utilities are proposed or required with the proposed use.

PUBLIC COMMENT

____ public comments were received. Upon discussion of use and conditions, there were ____ comments/objections/support to the Conditional Use Permit and Variance.

REVIEW

Dean Morgan, on behalf of SIG Properties LLC, dba Morgan's Meat Market, owner of the property. Dean Morgan is requesting a Conditional Use Permit and a Variance from the City of Waseca Code of Ordinances.

The **Conditional Use Permit** is from Section 154.022, Table 5-1: Summary of the Principal Permitted and Conditional Land Uses in the Business Districts. Custom Meat Processing in the B-3 District is allowed through a Conditional Use Permit. The previous zoning code listed Butcher Shops as a permitted use in the B-2, B-3, and B-4 Districts with no clarity or definition. The current zoning code (Adopted 2016) does not provide clarification on, or specifically allow for, custom processing and packaging of meat and poultry products for resale. Therefore, new and existing businesses of this type cannot legally conform to our zoning code. The addition of this use as conditionally permitted in the B-3, B-4, I-1, and I-2 districts can allow these activities to legally conform to those zoning districts while still being subject to conditions set by the City. The property currently meets/exceeds parking requirements.

The definition of Custom Meat Processing has been added to the Waseca Code of Ordinances 154.202 and is defined as: A facility for the indoors only processing of meat and poultry for wholesale and retail sales, including activities related to the cutting, smoking, grinding, and packaging of meat and poultry products, but specifically excluding slaughtering or rendering.

In granting a Conditional Use Permit, the following findings shall be made:

- The use is allowed as a conditional use in the zoning district and conforms to standard zoning regulations;
- The conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly use or development of nearby property, substantially diminish nearby property values or place an undue burden on public facilities or services;
- The conditional use will not be detrimental to the health, safety, morals, or welfare of the public;
- The conditional use will not result in a nuisance by odor, noise, or light;
- The conditional use will not unduly affect natural features.

The **Variance** is from Section 154.025, Table 5-7: Required Setbacks, B-3 District. The required minimum setback from the property line is 15 feet for the rear of a principal building. The proposed addition will encroach five (5) feet into the setback, leaving a distance of ten (10) feet. The property owner has spoken to the neighboring property owners and stated they have no concerns. The distance of ten (10) feet is required due to a platted drainage and utility easement. The encroachment request is reasonable due to the irregular shape of the parcel and placement of the original building. The setback width will allow for pedestrian traffic and building maintenance if required. There is adequate room for accessibility on the both the north (20 feet) and south (40 feet) sides of the addition.

The property owner, Dean Morgan has requested reimbursement by the City of the Variance Application Fee of \$520.00. This cost in addition to the \$700.00 for the Conditional Use Permit can be difficult for a local small business owner trying to keep and grow their business in Waseca.

In granting a Variance, the following findings shall be made:

- The Variance is in harmony with the purposes and intent of the ordinance.
- The use and variance are consistent with the comprehensive plan.
- The proposal puts the property to use in a reasonable manner.
- There are unique circumstances to the property not created by the landowner.
- The Variances, if granted, will not alter the essential character of the locality.

RECOMMENDATION

City Staff recommends approval of a Conditional Use Permit and Variance to allow Morgan's Meat Market to expand their meat processing business on the property located at 1100 2nd St NW, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All required federal, state and local permits and approvals shall be obtained and maintained.
- 2. The applicant shall obtain all necessary permits prior to beginning construction.
- 3. All costs associated shall be paid by the property owner.

REQUESTED ACTION

Hold a public hearing on the Conditional Use Permit and Variance request and take action on a recommendation to be forwarded to the City Council for consideration at their May 16, 2023 meeting.

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASECA CITY COUNCIL GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A CUSTOM MEAT PROCESSING BUSINESS AND A VARIANCE TO ALLOW A BUILDING ADDITION WHICH WILL ENCROACH INTO THE REQUIRED REAR SETBACK FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1100 2ND STREET NORTTHWEST

WHEREAS, application has been made to the City Council of the City of Waseca by Dean Morgan, on behalf of SIG Properties LLC, dba Morgan's Meat Market, owner of the property, for approval of a conditional use permit for the business use of Custom Meat Processing, and a variance from the provisions of Chapter 154 of the Waseca City Code to allow a building addition with a five (5) foot encroachment into the required fifteen (15) foot rear side setback. The property is located at 1100 2nd St NW and is described as:

All that part of Lot 2, Block 1, Lau's Subdivision, according to the recorded Plat thereof, Waseca County, Minnesota, lying Southerly of the following described line: Commencing at the NW corner of lot 2; thence South 00°00'00" East on the West line of Lot 2, bearings based on Lau's Subdivision, a distance of 187.00 feet to the point of beginning of the line to be described; thence South 89°35'37" East, a distance of 90.00 feet to the East line of Lot 2 and there terminating.

WHEREAS, the Waseca Planning Commission held a public hearing on the request at its May 9, 2023 meeting, and all interested parties were provided an opportunity to comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Waseca has considered the advice and recommendation of the Planning Commission, the consistency of the proposed project with the Waseca Zoning Ordinance, and the effect of the proposed use on the health, safety, and welfare of the occupants of the surrounding land, existing and anticipated traffic conditions, and the effect of the proposed use on the City's Comprehensive Plan, and the effect on property values in the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Waseca makes the following findings of fact related to the proposed development and requested conditional use permit and variance:

- 1. The use is allowed as a Conditional Use in the B-3 Zoning District.
- 2. The Conditional Use will not impede the normal and orderly use or development of nearby property, substantially diminish nearby property values or place an undue burden on public facilities or services.
- 3. The Conditional Use will not be detrimental to the health, safety, morals, or welfare of the public.
- 4. The Conditional Use will not result in a nuisance by odor, noise, or light.
- 5. The Conditional Use will not unduly affect natural features.
- 6. The Variance is in harmony with the purposes and intent of the ordinance.
- 7. The use and Variance are consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.
- 8. The proposal puts the property to use in a reasonable manner.
- 9. There are unique circumstances to the property not created by the landowner.
- 10. The Variance, if granted, will not alter the essential character of the locality.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Waseca that the Conditional Use Permit from Section 154.022, Table 5-1, and the Variance from Section 154.025, Table 5-7, Required Setbacks in the B-3 District, which requires a fifteen (15) foot rear setback for a principal building, is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The property shall be developed according to an approved site plan.
- 2. The property owner shall verify property line locations prior to any development.
- 3. All development on the property shall comply with the Waseca Code of Ordinances and State and Local Building codes.
- 4. All costs associated with this project shall be paid by the property owner.

BACKGROUND: City Council, at their work session on March 21, 2023, directed City staff to prepare a tentative schedule for the updating of the City's Comprehensive Plan. The proposed schedule (attached) has been divided into two (2) parts: Part 1 – Comprehensive Plan Review Schedule, and Part 2 – Schedule for Comprehensive Plan & Associated Ordinance Amendment Adoption. Below is a summary explanation of the main components of the proposed schedule and review process:

- Relevant aspects of Vision 2030 are to be incorporated into Chapter 1, Paragraph F Community Identity and Vision.
- Each Comprehensive Plan chapter's goals and objectives listed in Chapter 2 of the current Plan are to be presented along with its corresponding chapter. Therefore, Chapter 2 of the current Plan would be removed from the final updated Plan because the goals and objectives will be incorporated into their respective chapters.
- Each chapter will receive two (2) opportunities for community input through the Planning Commission review process. Agenda notices will be published in a local newspaper and on the City website so that interested parties will know which chapters are being reviewed and discussed. Public comments will be received at the beginning of each Planning Commission meeting.
- After each Planning Commission meeting, an update will be given to City Council at their next scheduled meeting. (With Planning Commission meetings held the 2nd Tuesday of every month, the Council update would then be presented at their meeting on the 3rd Tuesday of every month.) The update would be given during the "Requests and Presentations" portion of the Council meeting.

At their meeting on May 9, 2023, the proposed schedule was presented to the Planning Commission for their review. The Commission voted 5-0 to recommend approval of the process and proposed schedule with the following changes (which have been highlighted on the attached proposed schedule):

- Addition of two (2) Planning Commission work sessions on May 23, 2023 and June 27, 2023 to review the current Comprehensive Plan and Vision 2030.
- Clarification that the Planning Commission would have time to review the updated Comprehensive Plan as a whole from September December of 2024 before final adoption.

BUDGET IMPACT: None

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the City Council make a motion directing staff to proceed with the proposed Comprehensive Plan update process.

- Determine City treatment pond effectiveness
- Annual inspection of BMP's
- Staff training
- Documentation

Discharges to Impaired Waters

- Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)
 - Maximum amount of a pollutant allowed in a body of water
- Waste Load Allocation (WLA)
 - Maximum amount of a pollutant allowed to be discharged by an entity
- Pollutants currently regulated through the City's MS4 Permit
 - Total Suspended Solids (TSS)
 - Total Phosphorous (TP)

Suspended Solids & Phosphorous

- Total Suspended Solids (TSS)
 - Waterborne particles > 2 microns
 - Sand, silt, algae, plankton, bacteria
 - Impacts water clarity and quality
- Total Phosphorous (TP)
 - High levels cause excessive algae growth
 - Impacts water quality and aquatic life





Alum Treatment Systems

- Removes phosphorous from stormwater before it enters a body of water
- Loon Lake Alum Treatment Pond
 - Currently not operational
 - However, does provide some benefit as a settlement pond (TSS reduction)





2023 MS4 Improvements

- 2nd Street SW & 2nd Avenue SW Intersection Reconstruction Project
- Street Sweeping & Fall Leaf Pick-Up
 - Reduces Total Phosphorous
- Storm Sewer Inspections, Televising, & Cleaning
- Promote Park & Lake Clean-Up Events





Future MS4 Improvements

- Reconstruction of 8th Avenue NE (new linear project water quality requirements)
- · Continue to comply with all other MS4 permit requirements
- Provide access to stormwater information and opportunities for public involvement
- Partner with the Waseca Lakes Association and Waseca County to improve water quality in both Loon Lake and Clear Lake
