Dear Resident of Waseca:

The City of Waseca is applying for funds to help homeowners make improvements in your neighborhood, and we need your help! If we are able to demonstrate a lot of interest from the community, the program could be funded to provide a forgivable 0% interest loan for your home repairs.

To see how the program could work for you, read the attached "How the Home Repair Program Works," then follow the instructions below.

- For <u>ALL households</u>: As part of the application process, the City is required to collect short Surveys from as many households as possible. Even if you do not wish to borrow funds or feel you are not eligible, it is very important that we receive a short Survey from you. The survey is only five questions (see attached). <u>Surveys are due by February 26th</u>.
- For <u>homeowners INTERESTED in home repair funds</u>: After you complete the short survey on the front, continue on with the Survey on the backside if you are interested in home repair funds. Your name, contact information, and income are required for us to use your survey. This also places you on a waiting list, and you will be contacted to apply as soon as the funds are awarded, so please be as thorough as possible. Your response is due by February 26th.

If you have questions in completing your Survey, please call Joel at 507-836-1617. We've contracted with the Southwest Minnesota Housing Partnership to collect your surveys, <u>so your privacy will be maintained</u>.



How the Home Repair Program Works

Finance Example for Homeowners

Meet Tom & Maria.

Tom & Maria own a house in the target area. They live there with 2 kids; their household size is 4.

Their total income is \$49,000.


Tom & Maria's home needs repairs.



Step 1. Tom & Maria apply for the Home Repair Program.

- Step 2. An inspector looks at their house and makes a report.
- Step 3. Repair Program staff calculates the loan amount.

TOTAL ELIGIBLE REPAIR COSTS = \$25,000

0% Loan with 10 year term Forgiven 10% per year Deferred (no payments unless you default before 10 years)

If repairs are over \$25,000, the owner is responsible for the difference (using savings, loan, or match if available).

Step 4. Contractor is selected and repairs the home. Work should be done within 90 days from the start of construction.

Step 5. Tom & Maria live in the home for the 10-year loan term.



At the end of each year, 10% of Tom & Maria's Ioan is forgiven. 10% = \$2,500 After 10 years, the Ioan is 100% forgiven. If Tom & Maria move out after 5 years, 50% is forgiven and
