- 2. AAP participants are responsible for cleaning their site of trash, debris, and downed tree limbs.
- 3. Cleanup commitment of designated park, trails, open spaces is a minimum of once per month from April October.
- 4. AAP participants can also undertake other beautification efforts in their adopted area upon approval by Park Superintendent.
- 5. Park, trail, open space sites are chosen on a first come, first serve basis.

WHAT THE CITY PROVIDES:

- 1. Trash bags for cleanup
- 2. Coordinate pickup for trash, debris, limbs.
- 3. Materials required for approved improvements.
- 4. Recognition on City website and City newsletter
